**international scientific conference under the auspices  
of the Ministry of Science, Education and Youth**

## **Education Yesterday, Today, and Tomorrow: Consequences and Challenges of Technological Progress**

which will be held from October 21 to 23, 2026, in Brela (Bluesun Hotel Soline)

Education is the most important achievement of civilization and a prerequisite for its progress. It provides a space for applying knowledge and experience, as well as ethical and value orientations, without which no civilization has a future. Therefore, it is expected that the Croatian Academy of Educational Sciences, on the occasion of its significant 35th anniversary, will focus its scientific interest on the challenges of technological progress in education at all levels.

Education is truly interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary and should be considered without the dominance of any single science in the field. Only in this way can it be objectively observed, analyzed, and improved. For this reason, this scientific conference aims to analyze and research education from an interdisciplinary perspective within the new technological context that has defined the beginning of the 21st century. We seek to provide answers to questions about the future of society, humanity, and civilization, anticipating the future of educational theory and practice while considering the challenges of modern, especially rapid, technological development. This is the central focus of the Croatian Academy of Educational Sciences and all institutions co-organizing this scientific conference.

The conference, reflecting the complexity of the issues, is organized into three functionally unified yet distinct sections that capture the essence of contemporary educational sciences: general educational sciences and disciplines, special educational sciences and disciplines, and teaching methodologies along with other educational interdisciplines and transdisciplines.

**The conference was included in the Catalog of Professional Meetings of the Agency for Education for the year 2026**

**The conference will be held in plenary and in the following sections:**

- General educational sciences and disciplines (philosophy, theology, anthropology, history of education, pedagogy, andragogy, educology, etc.)

- Special educational sciences and disciplines (educational branches of psychology, sociology, communication sciences, law, economics, political science, information sciences, kinesiology, educational rehabilitation science, speech and language pathology, etc.)
- Teaching methodologies and other educational interdisciplines and transdisciplines.

If a sufficient number of participants register, a special expert panel is planned for employees in educational institutions and agencies.

### **Conference topics:**

- Current state of educational science theory and its influence on educational practice – a critical approach
- Mutual relations and the system of educational sciences
- Value orientations and identities, as well as the value system and goals of education
- Innovative achievements of individual educational sciences in theory and practice
- Problems in transmitting traditional didactics into a new curriculum system and criticism of current national and subject curricula
- The role of new technologies in the education system and the future of education
- Challenges of education in a digital environment
- Teaching methodologies and their foundational sciences in a modern approach to educational work
- The relationship between non-educational sciences and educational sciences in shaping educational theory and practice

The topics should be addressed in both an interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary manner, which is why the work is organized into sections corresponding to the structure of the Croatian Academy of Educational Sciences.

- Forms of participation include plenary presentations, oral presentations by sections, poster presentations, and participation without a presentation.

All papers that receive a positive international review will be published in the proceedings.

- The registration fee is mandatory for one author and for co-authors who are participating in the conference.

### **By paying the registration fee, the conference participant is entitled to:**

- participate in the conference
- publish up to two accepted articles in extenso
- receive conference materials, including the proceedings
- receive a certificate of participation and, if applicable, presentation
- attend the gala dinner for all participants on the second day of the conference (October 22, 2026), at the organizer's expense

**Submission of abstracts and full papers:**

Papers and abstracts may be submitted in Croatian or English. The total length of the paper, including the abstract and bibliography, is limited to 20 pages, with each page containing 1,800 characters including spaces. The abstract may be up to 1,300 characters including spaces. The APA citation style must be used, specifically the seventh edition of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (7th ed., 2020). The linguistic correctness of the papers published in the proceedings of the conference is the responsibility of the authors.

Papers that meet the publication criteria of the scientific journals Croatian Journal of Education (indexed in: SCOPUS, Web of Science, Social Sciences Citation Index (SSCI), Electronic Social and Science Citation Index (ESSCI), ERA - Educational Research Abstracts Online, HRČAK - Portal of Croatian Scientific and Professional Journals) and Napredak will, in addition to being published in the conference proceedings, also be published in one of these two journals.
